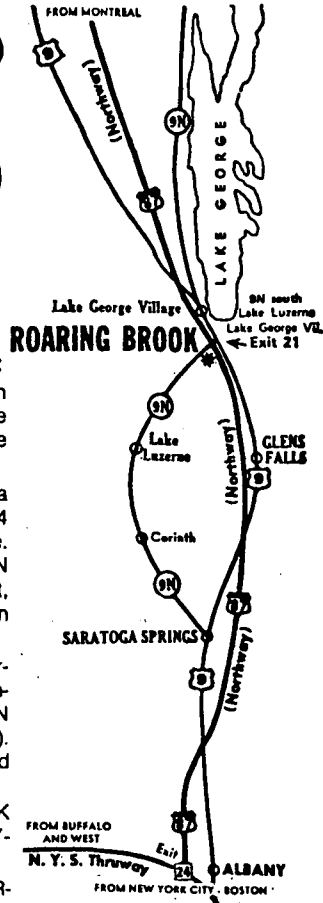

Located on Rte. 9N South (Lake George-Lake Luzerne Road) 2 miles SW of Lake George; 1 mile SW of Rte. 9.

**BY CAR:** From the South via N.Y.S. Thruway take Exit 24 at Albany and Interstate Rte. 87 (Northway) to Rte. 9N South, Exit 21. Turn left, watch for our road sign on left, about a mile.

**From the North—**U.S. Interstate 87 (Adirondack Northway) to Exit 21 (Rte. 9N South, Lake Luzerne Road). Turn right, watch for our road sign on left, about a mile.

**BY BUS:** ADIRONDACK TRAILWAYS or GREYHOUND to Lake George.

**BY AIR:** ALLEGHENY AIRLINES to Glens Falls, N.Y.

LIMITATIONS:

1. Any award resulting from this application will be a cash grant in advance of the ALLUNY Annual Meeting and will be made in an amount and in numbers to be determined annually by the Board of Directors of ALLUNY.
2. All funds awarded must be spent at or for travel to the stipulated ALLUNY Annual Meeting.
3. The grant will be repaid to ALLUNY if it cannot be spent as stipulated above or, if for reasons of personal disability, you cannot attend the meeting for which the grant is made. The grant is not cumulative or transferable.
4. Successful applicants for this annual grant will be chosen by lottery on September 8, 1980. A successful applicant will not be awarded a grant in two consecutive years.
