3. Your signature attests to application and acknowledges agreement to abide by the rules and limitations.

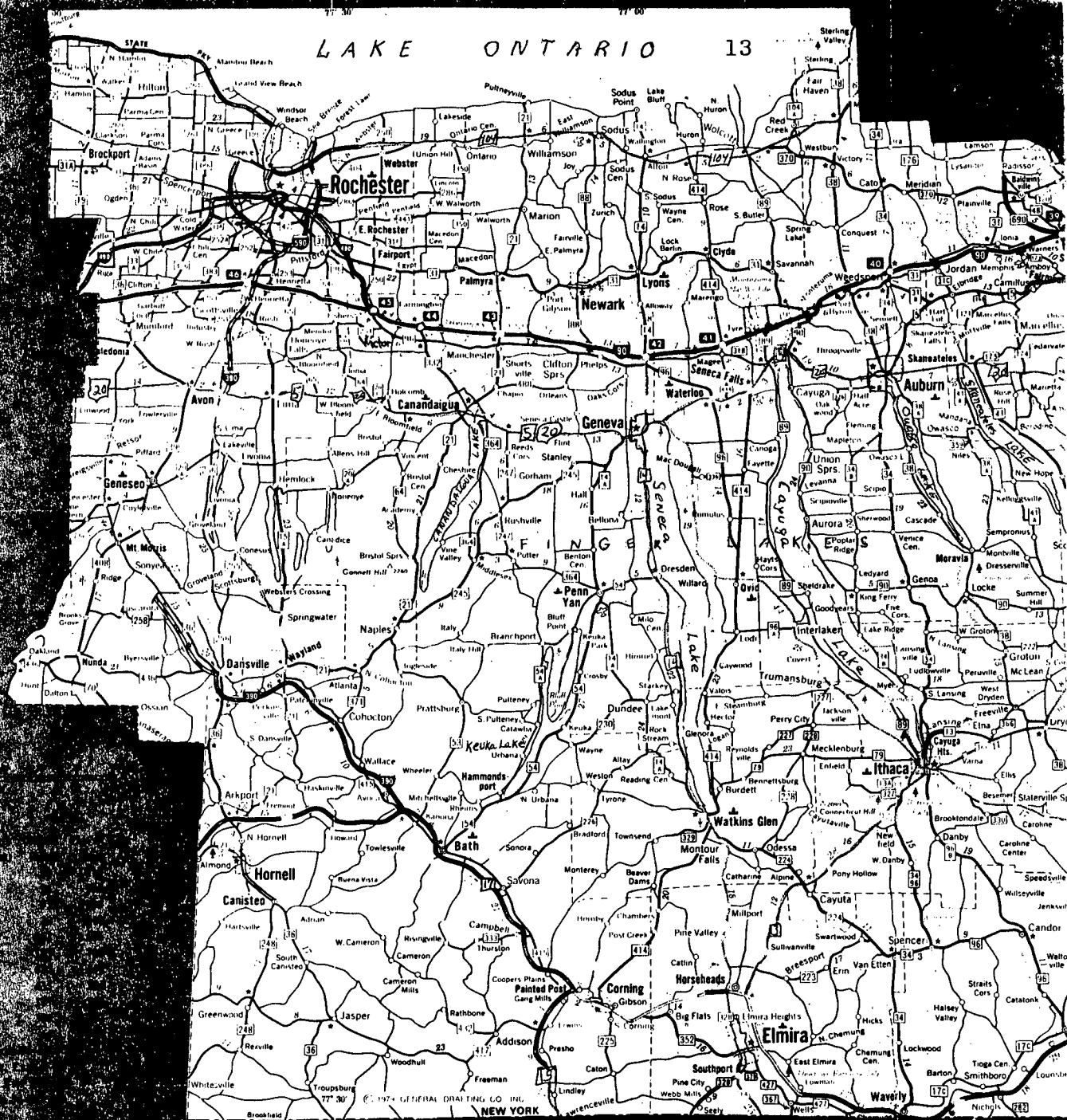
LIMITATIONS:

From the Rochester Airport: Turn right coming out of the airport onto route 390 South to the N.Y. State Thruway. Take the Thruway East toward Syracuse. Take exit 44 to route 332. Follow this into Canandaigua. Hotel is on the right.
