HOW TO GET TO NIAGARA FALLS, N.Y.

TO FLY: From NYC to Buffalo - *Empire Airlines - \$118.00 Round Trip Super Saver
*U.S. Air - \$114.00 Round Trip Super Saver

From Newark to Buffalo - *People Express - \$67.00 Round Trip (Depart
Friday, Return Sunday)
*U.S. Air - \$93.00 Round Trip Super Saver

From Albany to Buffalo - *Empire and U.S. Air - \$175.00 Round Trip

From Syracuse to Buffalo - *Empire and U.S. Air - \$95.00 Round Trip

From the Buffalo International Airport take the Niagara Hilton Limousine Service to the hotel - Approximately \$8.00 for the 30-minute trip. (It usually runs once per hour).

TO DRIVE: Take the NYS Thruway (I-90) west to Buffalo. Take Rt. 290 to Rt. 190. (This takes you over Grand Island). There are tolls on the Thruway and on Rts. 290 and 190. Take the Robert Moses Parkway to Niagara Falls. Turn right onto First St., right onto Mall and left onto Third St.

From southwest N.Y. and Ohio - Take I-90 to Rt. 290 etc.

Parking is \$2.00 per day but the hotel will cover half the cost for registered guests.

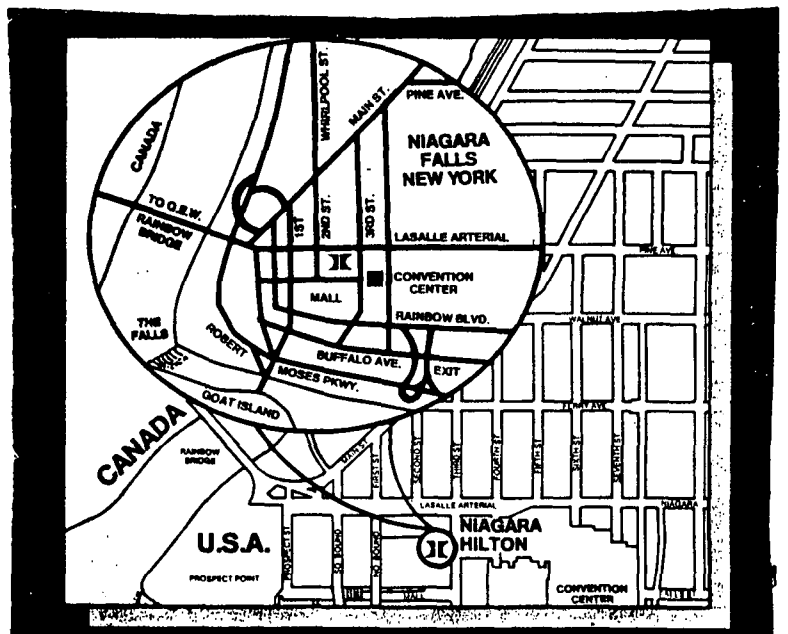
From NYC to Buffalo - Greyhound -\$79.55 Round Trip

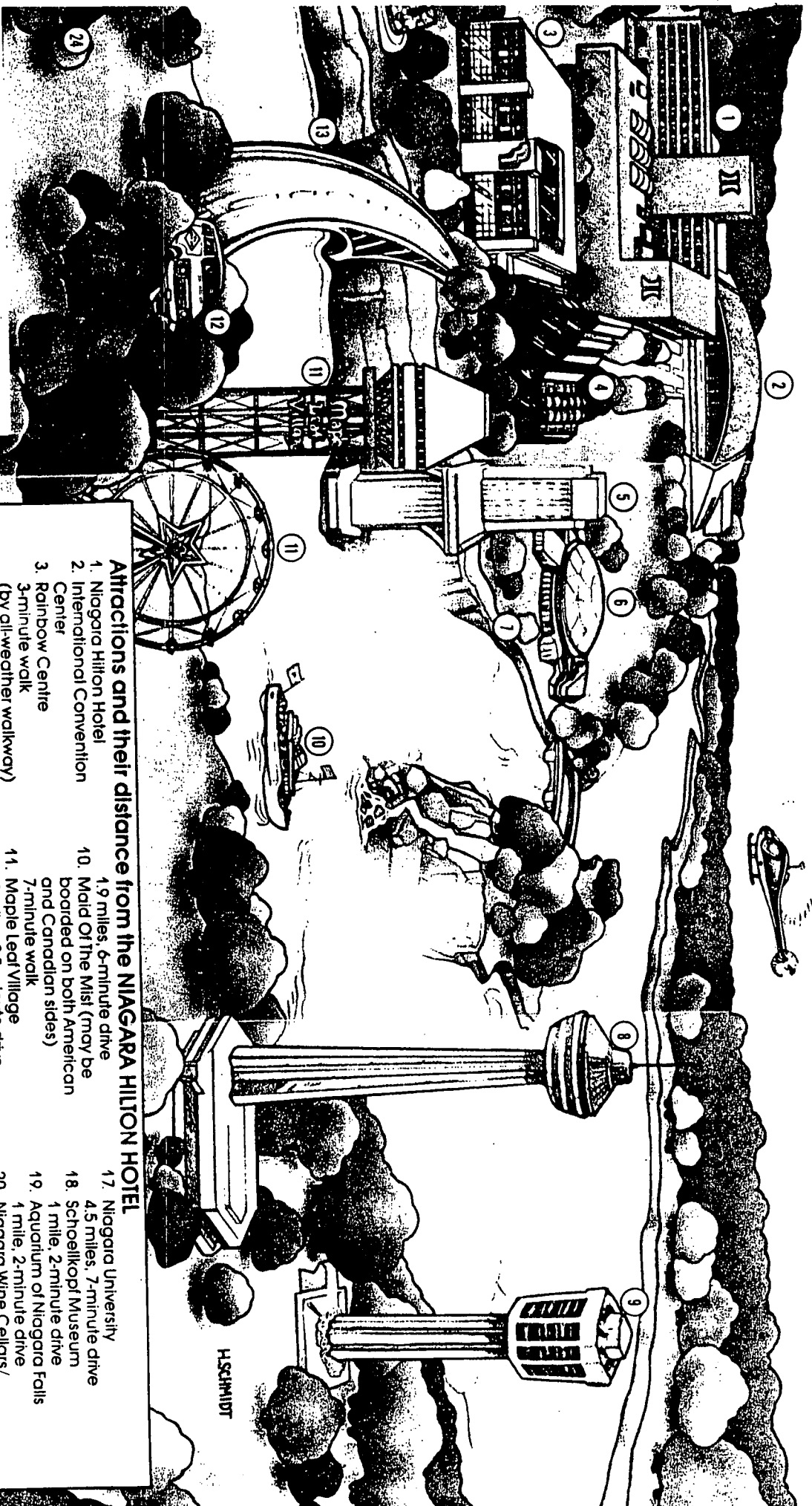
From Albany to Buffalo - \$54.45

In Buffalo you take a Metro Service bus to Niagara Falls. Cost = approximately \$1.10 each way.



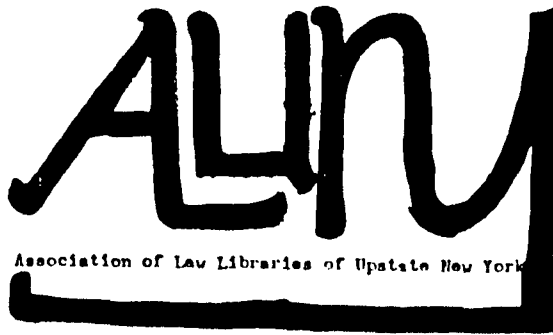


Attractions and their distance from the NIAGARA HILTON HOTEL

2. All funds awarded must be spent at or for travel to the stipulated ALLUNY Annual Meeting.
3. The grant will be repaid to ALLUNY if it cannot be spent as stipulated above or, if for reasons of personal disability, you cannot attend the meeting for which the grant is made. The grant is not cumulative or transferable.
